**NAAC Peer Team- 2008 Recommendations for Quality Enhancement of
the Institution & Measures Taken to Implement the Recommendations.**

The following are the recommendations of the NAAC peer team that visited the institution, PRR & VS Govt. College, Vidavalur in 2008, and the efforts that have been made over the years to implement these recommendations.

1] Encourage many more faculty members to pursue further studies for M.Phil, Ph.D; take up Minor/Major Research Projects, present papers in national-international research seminars, publish in refereed research journals and thus establish a vibrant research culture.

- Right from 2008 till date i.e 12-3-2015, many changes have taken place as far as the academic staff is concerned. During these years, some lecturers got retired, some regular lecturers went on promotion and some others on transfer to various colleges. At present there are one principal, eight permanent lecturers, nine contract lectures, two part-time lecturers, one JKC-Full Time Mentor and nine regular non-teaching staff members and one part time member.
- In the existing staff members, there are five doctorates [Dr D.GIRI, Principal, Dr N. Madhu, lecturer in physics, Dr. Umashankar Raju, lecturer in Botany, Dr. Chandra Purna, lecturer in Commerce, Dr. K. Karuna Sree, lecturer in Telugu] and there are six lecturers who are pursuing Ph.D. at present [Sri Ch.Krishna Murthy, Lecturer in English, Sri M.John Paul,lecturer in Botany,

Sri K.Joji, Lecturer in Political Science, Sri S.V.Nagendra Prasad, lecturer in Zoology, Sri N.Siva Rama Krishna, lecturer in Chemistry, Sri K.Deva Prasad, Lecturer in Computers.

Dr N.Madhu, lecturer in Physics, presented 2 papers in the National Seminar and published one book.

Sri M.John Paul, lecturer in Botany, has 10 paper publications to his credit which include 3 National and 7 International ones.

Sri Ch.Krishna Murthy, Lecturer in English, participated in 5 National seminars and presented papers. He attended one International seminar and presented paper. He also conducted UGC sponsored National Seminar in English on the theme " Emerging Trends in English Language Teaching –The Trans National Scenario" during 20th and 21st Feb 2015. He edited a book containing 45 articles and released during the inaugural session of the seminar.

Dr K.Karuna Sree, lecturer in Telugu, is going to publish one book. She had 3 paper publications to her credit. She participated in 8 National Seminars and 1 International Seminar and presented papers.

Sri K. Joji, lecturer in Political Science, attended one district and 2 National Seminars and presented papers.

Sri N.Siva Rama Krishna, lecturer in Chemistry attended 3 National and 2 International seminars and presented papers.

Dr M.Uma Shankar Raju, lecturer in Botany has to his credit 5 paper publications in international journals.

Sri B.Ashok Kumar, lecturer in Zoology has attended 2 National Seminars and presented papers. Both Zoology and Botany departments together conducted National Seminar on the theme "Bio-Diversity" in the college campus.

Dr D.Chandra Purna, lecturer in Commerce attended 5 National Seminars and presented papers.

Sri K.Deva Prasad, lecturer in Computers has 2 International publications to his credit.

Sri S.V.Nagendra Prasad, lecturer in Zoology attended 2 National seminars and presented papers. He conducted one National Seminar in our college campus. He has one publication in the international journal.

Sri B.Peerakumar, lecturer in Economics attended 4 National seminars and presented papers.

Sri P. Vijay Mahesh Kumar, librarian attended 4 National Seminars and presented papers. He has to his credit 2 paper publications in the journals.

2] Make all possible efforts to make the Contractual lecturers permanent.

Since the institution is under the purview of the CCE, AP, Hyderabad and it being the appointing authority, we frequently inform it about the recruitment of the regular faculty in place of the contract and part-time lecturers.

3] A permanent full time Physical Education Director to be appointed.

For the sanctioning of the post of a regular Physical Education Director to the institution, many a time we requested the CCE, AP to take action in this regard. But till now we have not received any communication regarding the appointment of the PED. The in-charge of commerce department has been entrusted with the duties of the PED for the time being.

4] Make much more use of UGC schemes.

A] With the UGC funds, the department of library has been enriched with the latest journals/reference books. A sophisticated Xerox machine with latest configuration has also been purchased for the benefit of the students who visit the library for reference books. Internet facility is also provided to the department of library.

B] Three computers, three printers, one scanner and one LCD projector are purchased and being used.

C] Civil works that include pipeline replacement was done under Plan Block Grant. Sanitation work exclusively for women students was done , meeting the funds from the UGC.

D] IQAC has also been enriched with a computer of latest configuration.

E] For the departments of Botany, Zoology, Physics and Chemistry , permanent equipment was purchased by utilizing the UGC funds.

5] Provide more, relevant courses for the students to choose from. Introduce Career Oriented and other job-oriented programmes as well as PG Programmes after due market research.

A] In 2011-12, M.Sc Chemistry course was sanctioned by the government. But due to lack of strength, we were not able to run it.

B] JKC was established in the institute for the purpose of giving training to the students in arithmetic, reasoning, soft skills and communication skills which are highly in demand and the most crying need of the times. A full time mentor was appointed to teach the JKC students reasoning, arithmetic and computer skills. A Guest English Mentor was appointed to teach communication skills as well as soft skills. During this academic year 2014-15, we have conducted three batches and recruited students for the fresh batch for the new academic year. Our students are being sent to the job drives conducted now and then and here and there. A student from our college JKC unit named Pragna-iii B. Com , joined Cadburys chocolate manufacturing industry.

C] Career –oriented Courses: Proposals for the introduction of career oriented programmes are likely to be submitted for the sanction by the government. Certificate courses also will be introduced with the consent of the government.

D] Proposals were sent for the sanction of the UG course namely B.Sc-MSCs(Maths , Statistics, Computer Science) it is likely to be introduced in the academic year 2015-16 immediately after getting the sanction orders.

E] The institution has introduced the restructured courses at UG level in commerce as B.Com Computer Applications, [English medium]. In sciences another course was reintroduced as B.Sc-MPCs(Maths, Physics and Computer Science)

6] Make concerted efforts to get more students enrolled-especially from general category.

Efforts are being made to enroll more students from general category .

7] Undertake many more community oriented activities, especially, using available expertise.

The institute has undertaken many community oriented programmes by using the available expertise. As part of that, it has established Red Ribbon Club, NCC and NSS wings in the college.

A] Red Ribbon Club: Under Red Ribbon Club activities much awareness is being created among the public and the students about the spread of AIDS and other such diseases and how to protect ourselves. It does so by conducting rallies in the village and with speeches given by the convener of the Red Ribbon Club. At present Sri K.Joji , Lecturer in Political Science is acting as the Convener of the Red Ribbon Club activities.

B] NSS: It is a wonderful support service that undertakes much community oriented activities. Some of them include Blood donation by students and villagers in collaboration with Red Cross Society, Nellore, village adaption, Clean and Green, improving sanitation etc..All these activities make the students participate actively in community oriented services and help them understand the problems existing in the society . Moreover these activities enhance their leadership qualities. At present Sri M. John Paul, Lecturer in Botany is acting as NSS coordinator.

D] NCC: In 2012-13 NCC Unit was established in the college campus. Sri B. Ashok Kumar, lecturer in zoology, is the Associate NCC Officer. Fifty students joined as cadets and were trained. Nearly forty students were qualified to get 'B' certificate. During the year 2013-14, fourteen cadets were qualified to get 'C' certificate. Sri P. Vijay Mahesh Kumar, librarian is acting as the Associate NCC Officer. During the year 2014-15, eighteen cadets appeared for 'B' certificate examination and the result is awaited.

8] Enhance infra structural facilities. Add more class rooms; reduce over use of existing facilities.

A] To improve hostel infrastructural facilities, a proposal under RUSA scheme was already sent to the CCE,A.P,Hyd .The process is under pipeline.

B] Proposals were sent for the establishment of English Language lab and the sanction is awaited.

9] Enhance existing hostel facilities for boys and provide such facility for girls.

The Department of Social Welfare has taken over the maintenance of the College Attached Hostel from the Academic year 2015-16. The department of Social Welfare, Government of A.P will surely improve the available infrastructural facility to the students. Separate proposals will be sent to the UGC, New Delhi for the establishment of women's hostel.

10] Promote much more participation in sports and cultural activities at least at the University level.

Under "Yuvatharangam" sponsored by the CCE,A.P, Hyd, many students from the institute are trained in sports and cultural activities to compete in the district and state level competitions. At present Sri B.Peera Kumar, Lecturer in Economics is acting as the in charge of the cultural activities. The students of the institute got good recognition from the district as well as state authorities by participating in all cultural events and bagging as many as four first prizes at district level and participation at the state level. In games and sports also the students have won many prizes in Kho-Kho and kabddi played at University level and statelevel.

11] Introduce schemes such as ‘earn while you learn’, entrepreneur development, part-time job-placement, distance learning etc.

Proposals will be sent for the sanction of Dr B.R Ambedkar Open University Centre in our institute . Students may be trained in self earning courses in future.

12]Expedite the process of installing institutional website; get Fax, e-mail facility, get more phone lines.

The institute has created its website www.gdcvidavalur.com during the year 2013-14 and information has been updated . Fax facility is available in the institute. Email facility is also available with email address vidavaluru.jkc@gmail.com . To provide Internet facility under NMEICT , more telephone lines are provided and this facility being extended to all the departments .

13]Establish an NCC unit. Ensure students give C, B Certificate exams; opt for careers in armed forces.

During the Academic year 2012-13 NCC unit was established in the institute. Sri B. Ashok Kumar, Lecturer in Zoology had been Associate NCC Officer for one year. Since Sep,2013 to till date Sri P.Vijay Mahesh Kumar , Librarian has been the Associate NCC Officer. During 2013-14, Fourteen cadets got ‘C’ certificate during 2014-15 as many as 18 cadets appeared for ‘B’ certificate examination.

14] Modernize library facility. Add many more volumes in the book bank.

Efforts are being made to modernize the library. A regular librarian was appointed during the year 2013-14. It will soon go for automation. New books for reference , textbooks for the students have been bought for their benefit . It has subscribed for Nineteen Journals and magazines, two news papers[one English& one Telugu].

15]Computerize office, library and other administrative systems.

The office is enriched with computer, printer and scanner, so treasury bills are being submitted online. A computer with internet facility is provided to the library.

16] Provide better health care facilities.

As part of providing health care to the students, health camps are being organized from time to time in the college campus . Very recently, doctors from reputed dental and Eye hospitals from Nellore made a visit and conducted health camp in the campus. They tested the eyes and teeth of all the students and the staff members and suggested medicines apart from giving medical advice.

17] Provide placement and career guidance services.

JKC Unit of the institution is providing training in various competition skills like soft skills, communication skills, Arithmetic skills , logical skills and Technical skills. There is also a placement and Career Guidance Cell that helps the students with various details regarding job opportunities, job drives conducted elsewhere etc. It displays news paper cuttings on the notice board from time to time for the enlightenment of students towards career opportunities.


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
