NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME(NSS)

Actions already taken and in regular force

- ❖ Strictly following time to time guidelines issued by the National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) and Information Education and Communication (IEC) and displayed posters in the College Campus.
- ❖ **COVID-19** Awareness Programme was conducted to Students and Staff and preventive Homeo-Medicine was distributed to all Students at our college before the lock-down on March, 2020.
- ❖ Posters with “**NO MASK – NO ENTRY**” have been pasted at entrance of College main gate and Class Rooms.
- ❖ The flexi banners are also enriched with information on mask usage, maintenance of physical distance and hand sanitization.
- ❖ College Staff i.e Principal, Lecturers and non-teaching staff are being thermal screened before permitting them to duty at the entrance gate with Thermal
- ❖ Hand sanitization is compulsory for all employees, students, and any visitors in the campus. Sanitizers are kept available at a table placed at the building entrances following **COVID-19** appropriate behaviour like wearing mask properly and maintain 6 feet physical distance is also mandatory in the campus
- ❖ To prevent the spread of **COVID-19**, essentials such as masks, sanitizers, and gloves etc. are purchased to meet the current demand.



Sanitized every class room before commencement of University Examinations

- ❖ Spitting and sneezing openly is strictly prohibited and covering the nose during sneezing with hand kerchief or tissue is advised and monitored. Such waste should be disposed at designated dust bins only.
- ❖ Adequate dust bins are available for waste disposal
- ❖ Promoting good respiratory hygiene in the workplace
- ❖ Wash rooms are being cleaned regularly with 1% sodium hypochlorite solution
- ❖ No employee exhibiting **COVID** like symptoms is permitted to attend duty.

Precautions already being taken while conducting examinations at our college

- ❖ No student and Invigilator should be allowed into examination centre without wearing full face mask.
- ❖ Students and Invigilators are sanitizing their hands before entering into examination hall.
- ❖ Thermal Scanning is must for all Invigilators and students while entering Into examination hall.
- ❖ Separate examination room allotted for Symptomatic students.
- ❖ Every student should abide by physical distancing norms in the examination hall and should maintain personal hygiene by washing hands with soap/sanitizer and should sneeze either in tissue paper or into the Elbow.
- ❖ Invigilators are instructed and monitored to maintain a safe distance of minimum 6 feet between the two students (One Dusk – One Student) during examinations and maintain physical distance from others.
- ❖ Bags or books or mobile phones should not be allowed in the examination center.
- ❖ On completion of exam, the candidates should be permitted to move out in an orderly manner.

Action Plan for Future

- ❖ One more awareness programme will be conducted on COVID-19 to the students and staff by the experts after reopening of the colleges.
- ❖ Students and Staff will not be allowed to share objects like books, pens, laboratory equipment and etc., without sanitizing.
- ❖ Discourage sharing of items, especially those that are difficult to clean or disinfect.
- ❖ Students will be encouraged to enter college duly wearing full face mask properly and every student will be allowed to enter the college only after thermal screening at the entrance. All students' hands will be sanitized at entrance gate

- ❖ Students will be encouraged to hand wash with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or using a hand sanitizer (containing at least 60% alcohol).
- ❖ Hand washing and proper wearing full face mask techniques will be pasted in the class rooms and wash basin areas.
- ❖ Students will be advised not to congregate in rooms.
- ❖ No students with symptoms like fever, cold, cough will be allowed to enter the college
- ❖ Lunch places will be sanitized with 1% sodium hypochlorite solution just before lunch hour and all students entering the lunchroom shall be encouraged to wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds before and after lunch.
- ❖ Pamphlets on COVID appropriate behavior are prepared, distributed, and are kept ready to be affixed inside classrooms and library at the time of the reopening of the college.
- ❖ COVID-19 Precautions and Instructions will pass to Students by Whats App groups regularly.

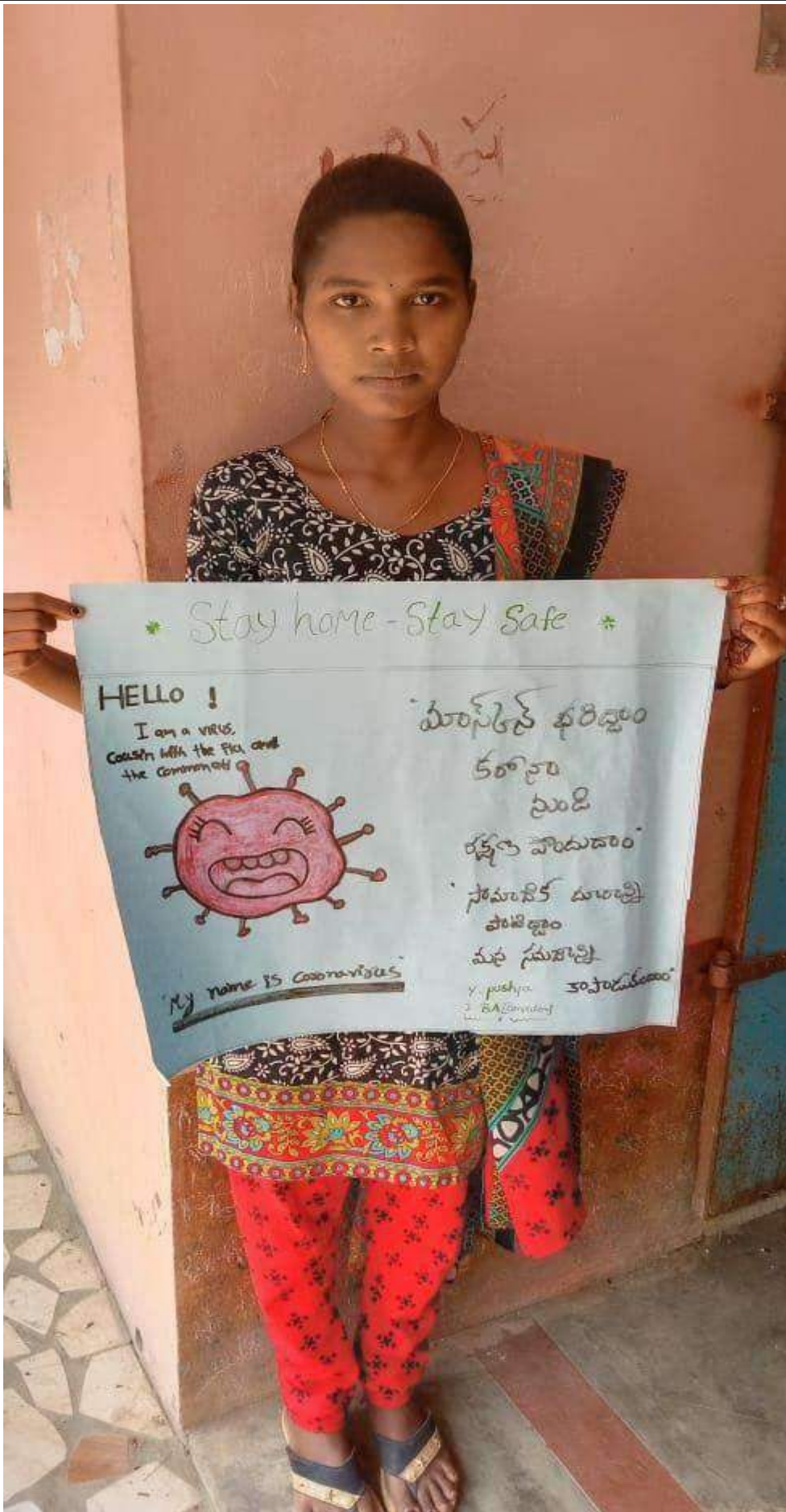

In India itself about eighty thousand people are killed in road crashes every year which is thirteen percent of the total fatality all over the world. Man behind the wheel plays an important role in most of the crashes. In most of the cases crashes occurs either due to carelessness or due to lack of road safety awareness of the road user. 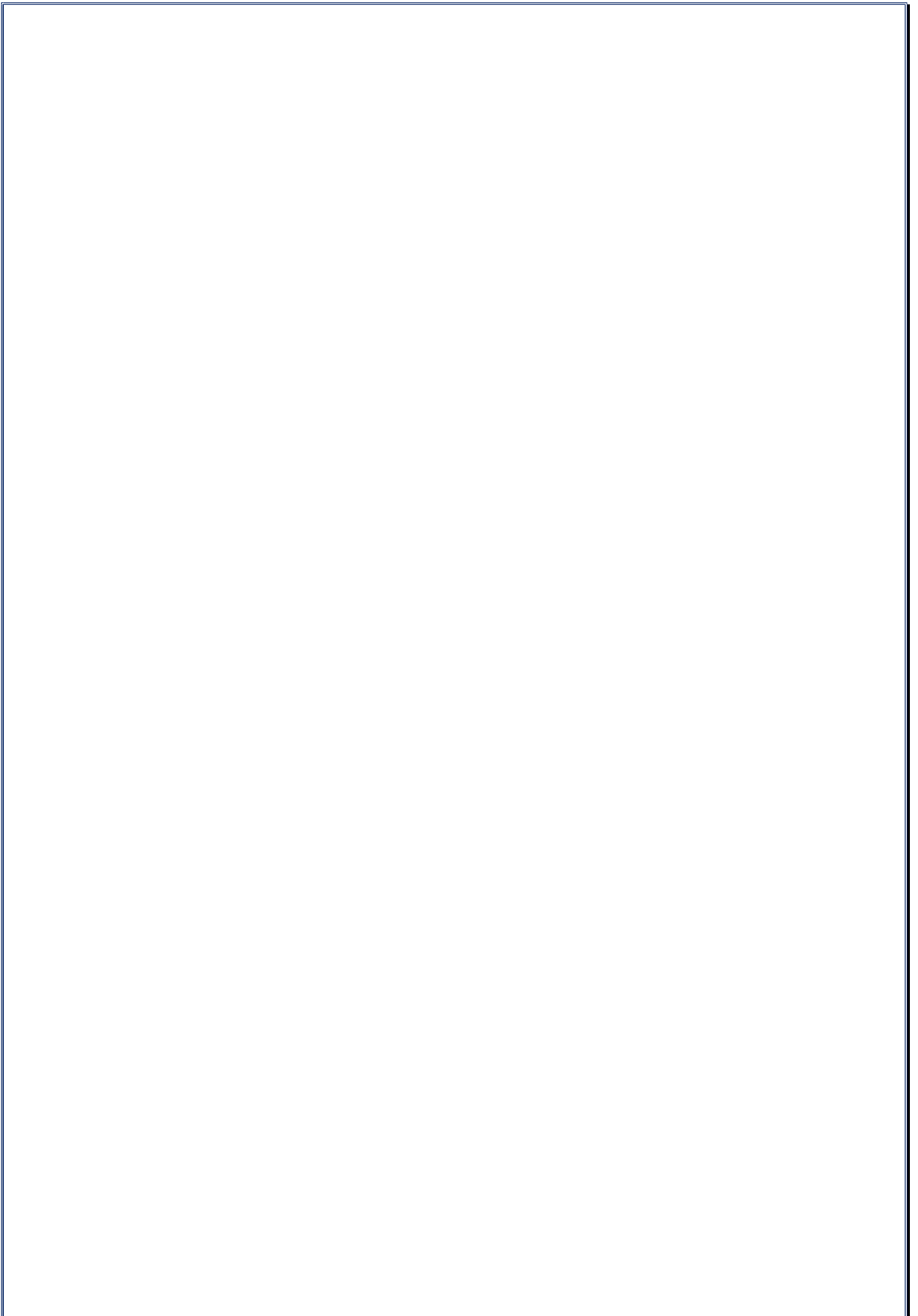

COVID – 19 PANDAMIC :: NSS Activities

On the evening of 24 March 2020, the Government of India ordered a nationwide lockdown for 21 days, limiting the movement of the entire 1.38 billion (138 crores) population of India as a preventive measure against the COVID-19 pandemic in India.

On 1 May, the Government of India extended the nationwide lockdown further by two weeks until 17 May. The Government divided all the districts into three zones based on the spread of the virus—green, red, and orange—with relaxations applied accordingly. On 17 May, the lockdown was further extended until 31 May by the National Disaster Management Authority.

During this Lockdown period, in the month of April, 2020, our college NSS Volunteers were decided to distribute food packets to poorer sections in nearest areas of their own villages, where the people really suffering to fulfill their basic need like food, in those areas the Volunteers were supplied food packets and given precautions about Covid-19 pandemic.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

On September 24, 1969, the then Union Education Minister Dr. V.K.R.V. Rao, launched the NSS programme in 37 universities covering all States and simultaneously requested the Chief Ministers of States for their cooperation and help. It was appropriate that the programme was started during the Gandhi Centenary Year as it was Gandhi Ji who inspired the Indian youth to participate in the movement for India's independence and the social upliftment of the downtrodden masses of our nation.

The cardinal principle of the programme is that it is organised by the students themselves and both students and teachers through their combined participation in social service, get a sense of involvement in the tasks of national development. Besides, the students, particularly, obtain work experience which might help them to find avenues of self-employment or employment in any organisation at the end of their university career.

The scheme now extends to all the states/Union Territories and universities in the country and covers Councils of +2 level in the country also in many states. Students, teachers, guardians, persons in authority in government, universities and colleges/schools and the people in general now realize the need and significance of NSS. It has aroused among the student youth an awareness of the realities of life, a better understanding and appreciation of the problems of the people. NSS is, thus, a concrete attempt in making campus relevant to the needs of the community. There are several instances of excellent work and exemplary conduct of NSS units which have earned them appreciation respect and confidence of the people. The special camping programmes organised under the themes of 'Youth Against Famine (1973)', 'Youth Against Dirt & Disease (1974-75)', 'Youth for Eco-Development' and 'Youth for Rural Reconstruction' 'Youth for National Development and Youth for Literacy (1985-93)' 'Youth for National Integration and Communal Harmony (1993-95)' have resulted in gains both to the community as well as to the students. The theme for the year 1995-96 onwards for Special Camping is 'Youth for Sustainable Development with focus on Watershed Management and Water land Development'. Themes have been selected in accordance with national priorities. Also, from 1991-92 onwards NSS has launched a nationwide campaign on AIDS Awareness called

"Universities Talk AIDS" (UTA) which has earned international attention and appreciation.

Community service rendered by university and +2 level students has covered several aspects like adoption of villages & Urban slums for intensive development work, carrying out the medico-social surveys, setting up of medical centres, programmes of mass immunization, sanitation drives, adult education programmes for the weaker sections of the community, blood donation, helping patients in hospitals, helping inmates of orphanages and the physically handicapped etc. NSS volunteers rendered commendable relief work during natural calamities/emergencies such as cyclones, floods, famine, earthquake, tsunamis etc from time to time all over the country. The NSS students have also done useful work in organising campaigns for eradication of social evils, and popularization of the nationally accepted objectives like nationalism, democracy, secularism, social harmony and development of scientific temper.

Objectives of NSS

The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

- i. understand the community in which they work
- ii. understand themselves in relation to their community
- iii. identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem-solving
- iv. develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility
- v. utilise their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems
- vi. develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities
- vii. gain skills in mobilising community participation
- viii. acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes
- ix. develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and
- x. practise national integration and social harmony

INTERNATIONAL AIDS DAY

01.12.2018

World AIDS Day, designated on 1 December every year since 1988, is an international day dedicated to raising awareness of the AIDS pandemic caused by the spread of HIV infection and mourning those who have died of the disease. Government and health officials, non-governmental organizations, and individuals around the world observe the day, often with education on AIDS prevention and control.

World AIDS Day is one of the eight official global public health campaigns marked by the World Health Organization (WHO), along with World Health Day, World Blood Donor Day, World Immunization Week, World Tuberculosis Day, World No Tobacco Day, World Malaria Day and World Hepatitis Day.

As of 2017, AIDS has killed between 28.9 million and 41.5 million people worldwide, and an estimated 36.7 million people are living with HIV, making it one of the most important global public health issues in recorded history. Thanks to recent improved access to antiretroviral treatment in many regions of the world, the death rate from AIDS epidemic has decreased since its peak in 2005 (1 million in 2016, compared to 1.9 million in 2005).

The NSS unit was provided with many videos regarding AIDS Awareness programme. These videos are exhibited to the people of the village to enhance the AIDS Awareness. A rally was conducted by the NSS volunteers of the special camp by

exhibiting different types of placards on which slogans against AIDS were written. This programme was conducted in an association with red ribbon club of the college.

By giving those slogans the NSS volunteers covered the entire village. They distributed some pamphlet about AIDS disease. The staff members of the college and the remaining students of the college were involved in the rally.

Sri A.V. Ramana Rao, Incharge Principal of this college appreciated the efforts of the NSS volunteers. Some the rural youth was also involved in the rally.

Human Rights Day 2018 - December 10

The Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) was adopted on 10 December 1948. The date has since served to mark Human Rights Day worldwide. The High Commissioner for Human Rights, as the main UN rights official, and her Office play a major role in coordinating efforts for the yearly observance of Human Rights Day. The day commemorates the work of human rights organizations and all those people with consistent efforts and defend the human rights worldwide. The existence of Human Rights Day came into effect when United Nations Assembly has adopted the "Universal Declaration of Human Rights which was the first global enactment for human rights. All over the world many people among them some are renowned and some are anonymous whether in groups, organization or being alone working towards the campaign of Human Rights in order to end discrimination. Many governmental and non-governmental organizations are also actively participated in various activities of Human Rights Day so that people everywhere of the world learn about their HumanRights. The United Nations General Assembly proclaims the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as a common standard of achievement for all peoples and all nations, to the end that every individual and every organ of society, keeping this Declaration constantly in mind, shall strive by teaching and education to promote respect for these rights and freedoms and by progressive measures, national and international, to secure their universal and effective recognition and observance, both among the peoples of Member

States themselves and among the peoples of territories under their jurisdiction. **The Human Rights Day promotes and spread awareness about the following articles under UDHR:**

- All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights.
- Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms set forth in this Declaration, without distinction of any kind, such as race, color, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status.
- Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person.
- No one shall be held in slavery or servitude; slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms.
- No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.
- Everyone has the right to recognition everywhere as a person before the law.
- All are equal before the law and are entitled without any discrimination to equal protection of the law.
- Everyone has the right to an effective remedy by the competent national tribunals for acts violating the fundamental rights granted him by the constitution or by law.
- No one shall be subjected to arbitrary arrest, detention or exile.
- Everyone is entitled in full equality to a fair and public hearing by an independent and impartial tribunal, in the determination of his rights and obligations and of any criminal charge against him.

- Everyone has the right to freedom of movement and residence within the borders of each State. Everyone has the right to leave any country, including his own, and to return to his country.
- Everyone has the right to a nationality. No one shall be arbitrarily deprived of his nationality nor denied the right to change his nationality.

National Human Rights Commission

(NHRC) has been constituted under Human Right Act 1993. This has been the milestone of promotion and protection of human rights in Indian society. In India the celebration of Human Rights Day on **December 10**, gives us an opportunity to judge the accountability to human rights standards. The day is also celebrated to promote the universal human rights: to live and to do so peacefully. **Human Rights issues in India** relate to trafficking of women and children, food security, right to education and health, disappearance of persons, displacement of persons due to disasters, conflicts and development, child labor, custodial deaths, violation of Human Rights in prisons and the disabled etc. On these issues, the Commission is not only dealing with individual cases but also issuing policy guidelines for implementing agencies.
