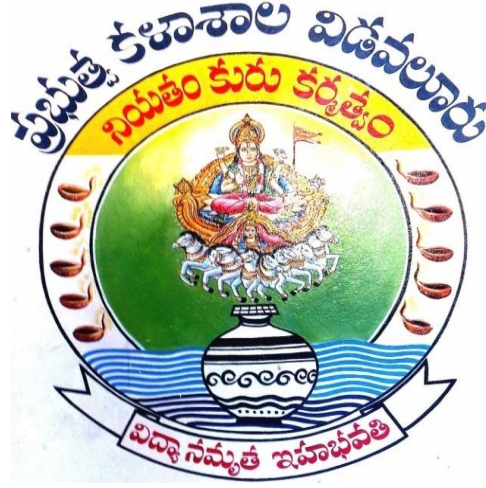

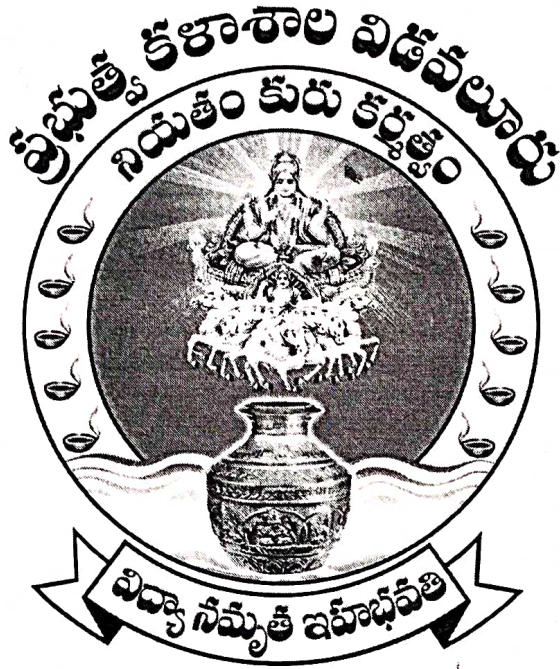

This is more in a democratic system. It means, everyday he devotes some time either for understanding or for deciding political events & problems. For example, as a citizen he casts his vote; helps advise and criticizes the government. As a representative or as a politician, he administers the nation efficiently and effectively. So, theoretical and practical knowledge of political science is highly useful to modern executives and judges who need models of forms that can be applied to immediate situation.

Principle valuable: It is, however, said that political theory ignores reality; its methods are rude & uncertain, its terminology is vague and its concepts narrow and its conclusions incorrect and it cannot give a final answer key to any question. This is not true. It has laid down certain universal principles that are applicable for all times and ages. State is natural & man is social, said Aristotle. Man is selfish and corrupt concluded Hobbes and Machiavelli, "Power corrupts and absolute power corrupts absolutely", declared Lord Acton. Concentration of power means dictatorship and separation of powers mean liberty, affirmed Montesquieu.

Importance of the study of Political Theory:-

• Teaches about rights and duties:- It enables the citizen to understand the aims and functions basis and purpose of state. It teaches him his own position in regard to state. It explains his rights and duties how he should make use of them. Lessons of Politics, like the lessons of History, are fruitful useful and valuable. Political Science:-

What are the essential elements of state? Illustrate your answer with examples.

What are rights? What are different kinds of rights.

Answers:-

Introduction:-

Politics is defined as the "science of state". State is a pivot around which politics revolves. But unfortunately, "state" is the most confused word in politics. It is used in different meanings by different states. For example when we say Andhra Pradesh state or Karnataka state, we really mean Andhra Pradesh or Karnataka state. When we say government railways or government schools, we really mean state.

Meaning of state:-

The word state has scientific meaning. Being a student of politics, we shouldn't use the word/term state loosely. Max Weber defined state as "a community of people more or less numerous permanently occupying fixed territory which is free from external control and possessing own government to which the inhabitants render habitual obedience". State primarily consists of four elements. They are i) Population ii) Territory iii) Government iv) Sovereignty.

Population:- state is a human institution. It works for the development of man. People may be of different kinds. They may be the rich or the poor,

or disconnected (Indonesia, Lakshadweep etc).

Small states are said to be well organised & have good governance. England is a very small state but at one time it became the master of the world. In recent times, small state like Israel acted the allied powers of 6 Arab states. Small states like Japan & Germany, Korea etc are said to be well developed.

Government:- It is the agent of the state. It passes rules & regulations and maintain law & order in the state. It works for the common good of the people, through it peace is secured & democracy is obtained. It is divided into three main branches viz; legislative, executive, judiciary. There are different types of government democratic, parliamentary, presidential, dictatorship, monarchy, aristocracy etc. State exercises its authority through government. For all practical purposes, government means state. So it is essential for the development of state.

iv.) Sovereignty:- It is the most important element of the state. It simply means supreme power. This element of state distinguishes it from associations, clubs etc. It is of two types:

i.) Internal sovereignty:- state can pass any laws or can follow any policies that it likes within the state.

ii.) External sovereignty:- It means it has complete freedom either to declare war or to conclude peace. It means freedom from foreign control.

reason ii.) These should not be slavery.

3.) Right to work:- It means the state should provide his people with work. It includes three things

i.) Adequate wages; ii.) Reasonable hours of work; iii.) Satisfactory conditions of work. U.S.S.R is the only state to employ this right effectively.

4.) Right to education:- It is the duty of the state to educate his people; "educate masters". Education is "a long run process belongs to those who grasp & form ideologies" (Laski). If it doesn't educate its people the state will be the one who loses ultimately.

5.) Right to Property:- It is the right to enjoy their own property. Communist countries have not granted this right. Even democratic countries have granted this right with many limitations. According to 44th amendment of Indian constitution this right is removed from the fundamental rights.

6.) Right to freedom of speech & press:- This right gives the freedom to speak & express things freely. It develops moral outlook. It doesn't mean publishing of vulgar literature & abusing others. It closely relates to the freedom of press. It means the press & news papers have total freedom to publish any type of news & it shouldn't be controlled by the government.

7.) Right to Assemble & Associations:- Associations are helpful for the development of man in all spheres. It also grants the right to protest. Government has the right to stop harmful associations. Right to assemble means right to gather freely without arms.
