I have immense pleasure in welcoming you all to the 53rd College Annual Day Celebrations in our college. It's my duty and privilege to present the annual report of the college that includes all the activities and achievements during the academic year 2017-18.

Brief History of the Institution:

Our college was established way back in 1965, with the noble and generous donations from Sri Ponnaluru Ramachandra Reddy and some other philanthropists. Having been built in a sprawling campus of 11.72 acres of land in a sylvan atmosphere, our college is free from urban pollution. Having produced many eminent persons with leadership qualities of head and heart, our college has stood firmly as a centre for learning. I assure that we are committed to provide quality and job oriented education to our students. The college is now affiliated to Vikrama Simhauri University- Nellore. It came into effect from 2010-11 onwards.

The college was Re-accredited with “B” Grade by the NAAC, Bangalore, in the year 2015 with the inspiration and support extended to us by the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad. Our college runs in two sessions. At present our college strength is 282. They include 217 boys and 65 girls. Among the teaching staff, there are 11 permanent lecturers, 5 contract lecturers, 3 guest faculty members and one JKC mentor. There are 9 members of the non-teaching staff. In our college, we offer courses like B.Sc. (MPC, MPCs, BZC), BA (HEP) and B.Com. (CA). This year two new courses, BA (ESCA) and B.Sc. (MSCS) have been introduced.

College Attached Hostel:

The growth of the college mainly depends on the college attached hostel. It is a gift to the students who come from far off areas to study here. Commenced as student managed hostel in 1969 in a private building, it was later converted into College Attached Hostel in 1999 and was shifted to its own building constructed on the campus in the year 2008. The alumni of this college played a catalytic role in the construction of the hostel building on the campus. After utilizing the RUSA funds, the college attached hostel has completely been renovated and has started functioning from September 2018.

DRC Activities:

As part of District Resource Centre activities, this year the Department of Telugu organized a one day seminar on “Avadhana Vidya: Avagahana” on 18.02.2016. Renowned Telugu Scholars Sri Kota Rajasekhar, Astavadhani and Sri Mylavarapu Murali Krishna, Astavadhani very effectively talked about the greatness avadhanam. Sri Kandi Sankaraiah, a very good Telugu writer from Telangana also graced the occasion. Students and staff from many colleges in our district attended the seminar and made it a grand success.

It is a practice that the DRC meetings continuously conducted at the Identified college, Nellore. Because of the initiative taken by the Principal of ID college, for the first time it has been decentralized and held at our college on 6th September 2017.

Special Occasions:

In addition to the celebration of the national festivals like Independence Day, Republic Day, we also celebrated various important days like International Yoga Day on 21.06.2017, International Drug Day on 27.06.2017, International Youth Day on 12.08.2017, Anti Ragging Awareness Programme on 21.08.2017, Mathrubasha Dinoshanam on 29.08.2017, N.S.S Day on 25.09.2017, Indian Constitution Day on 26.11.2017, World AIDS Day on 1.12.2017, National Human Rights day on 11.12.2017, World Food Day on 16.10.2017, National Youth Day on 20-01-2018, National Voters’ Day on 25-01-2018, and International Women’s’ Day on 08.03.2018 .

Janmabhumi Activities:

As per the instructions from the Govt. of A.P., Janmabhumi programme was conducted from 2nd January 2018 to 11th January 2018. All the students and staff actively participated in that programme, and various competitions were conducted on that occasion.

Extension Activities:

Several guest lecturers have been organized by various departments of our college. Our lecturers were invited by various other colleges to deliver their lectures in their respective fields.

A programme under the banner Red Cross Society of India was conducted on Disaster Management to educate the students regarding self-protection from fire accidents. Sri. R. Gnana Sundaram, Regional Fire Officer, Tirupai (the then District Fire Officer, Nellore) along with his crew and equipment conducted this programme. The students and staff of our college participated enthusiastically in this programme and learnt several things.

NSS Activities:

On 24th Sep 2017, NSS Day was organized. Sri John Paul, Lecturer in Botany and NSS programme officer conducted a meeting. The students were advised to participate in various social welfare activities. Clean and green activities were done in the college campus.

NCC Activities:

The 68th NCC day was celebrated on the college campus by the cadets under the supervision of Associate NCC Officer P. Vijay Mahesh Kumar on 23-11-2017. The cadets performed NCC drill before the Principal and also did "Guard of Honour" programme. On this occasion, all NCC cadets participated in the Swatcha Bharath Programme conducted in the college campus.

The NCC Officer participated in a training programme at OTA Kamptee from 3rd July to 22nd Jul 2017.

Red Cross Unit:

All the students of the college were enrolled as volunteers in College Red Cross Unit. Red Cross volunteers participated in Blood Donation Programme on various occasions and donated about 20 Units for Red Cross Nellore.

Activities of the Red Ribbon Club:

Our college students participated in Blood Donation camp at Vidavaluru on the occasion of National Voters Day on 25.01.2018 conducted by Indian Red Cross Society, Nellore. A rally was also organized in which Principal, staff and students participated. Sri Muddapati Suryanarayana, M.A. District Revenue Officer (Retd.), an alumnus of this institution also graced the occasion.

UGC & RUSA:

Sri A. V Raman Rao, Lecturer in Physics is acting as UGC & RUSA Coordinator. Under RUSA (Rastria Uchatar Siksha Abhian) scheme an amount of two crore rupees was sanctioned. An amount of one crore rupees has already been released. APEWIDC (Andhra Pradesh Education Welfare Infrastructure Development Corporation) has undertaken the civil works. Renovation and electrification of college building that includes hostel and conversion of three old rooms into digital class rooms took place. A new seminar hall and two e-class rooms have been constructed, but because of the implementation GST w.e.f. 1st July 2017, there was 12% hike in the cost of the project. So the electrification and beautification works have not been completed. In this connection, it is estimated that an amount of Rs. 4 lakhs is required for which proposals to seek funds from the state government is in pipe line. Physical verification committee consisting of the RJDCE and the Principal of Identified College visited the college on 9th November 2017 to check the progress of the project in terms of financial and physical aspects and final report was also submitted to the SPD RUSA. The State Project Director RUSA, Sri K. Hariprasad also visited the campus and addressed the gathering of the students.

Biometric Attendance System:

As per the instructions from the Government of AP, we have installed three biometric face recognition devices for both staff and students.

Virtual Class:

Virtual Class is a wonderful initiative by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. Utilizing the RUSA funds, our Commissionerate of Collegiate Education has taken excellent measures to establish the virtual class in our college. Using this virtual class, we not only conducted classes by our lecturers but also we attended the video conferences conducted by our Commissioner of Collegiate Education. These activities are monitored by Sri P.S. Sridhara Sarma, Lecturer in

Physics. It is my privilege to inform you that Sri. A. Venkata Prasad, Lecturer in Economics and Dr. R.V.S Prasad, Reader in Statistics of our college have been appointed as conveners to design the time table for virtual class room.

AP Fibre net:

We have got 100 MBPs broadband internet connection and 10 MBPs leased line under RUSA scheme.

Solar Power:

Under RUSA scheme, we have been given equipment relating to 10 KW solar power panels. They have been installed and very soon it is going to be connected to the power grid.

Physical Education Activities:

Initially Mr. A.V. Prasad, Lecturer in Economics and later Mr. K. Balakoteswara Rao, Lecturer in Mathematics played vital role in monitoring the physical education activities in the

absence of the physical director. Our college students participated at district, state university and interuniversity, National level sports and games tournaments during 2017-18.

Library:

We have a good library in our college with nearly 15,060 books. Now the library is fully equipped with the latest magazines and has become a rich resource of knowledge for all categories of students and staff to sharpen their minds. The library equipped with NLIST e-Journals along with print journals and library is automated with “SOUL” software and work is in progress. Withdrawal of old books is also an important work which is going on in the library.

Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC):

The College has a Jawahar Knowledge Centre, which is a platform for training the students in strengthening their employability skills. The Principal of the institution is the Chairman of JKC. Dr. V. Sri Rama Murthy, Lecturer in English is the Coordinator, and Mr. B. Murali Krishna is the Mentor. The students who join JKC are trained in soft skills, communication skills, analytical skills and computer skills to make them competent to face the challenges in the job market. Personality development also is made a part of their JKC curriculum. This year a good number of JKC trained students got placements and admissions into higher education courses.

This year a Job drive was conducted by TVS Training and Services in which 43 candidates appeared for the interview and 10 were selected. 8 more students got selections in off campus selections.

Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS):

As part of the MoU between the Government of Andhra Pradesh and Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), a diploma course has been introduced for the students of Degree courses. Some of our lecturers have been given orientation in English Communication, Financial Literacy, Analytical Skills, Digital Literacy, Youth Leadership and People’s Skills and Social Entrepreneurship to train our students from first year onwards.

AP Skill Development Centre:

AP Skill Development Centre has been established in this college. We have been given 30 Laptops, 30
