I have immense pleasure in welcoming you all to the 54th College Annual Day Celebrations in our college. It's my duty and privilege to present the annual report of the college that includes all the activities and achievements during the academic year 2018-19.

Brief History of the Institution:

Our college was established way back in 1965, with the noble and generous donations from Sri Ponnaluru Ramachandra Reddy and some other philanthropists. Having been built in a sprawling campus of 11.72 acres of land in a sylvan atmosphere, our college is free from urban pollution. Having produced many eminent persons with leadership qualities of head and heart, our college has stood firmly as a centre for learning. I assure that we are committed to provide quality and job oriented education to our students. The college is now affiliated to Vikrama Simhauri University- Nellore. It came into effect from 2010-11 onwards.

The college was Re-accredited with "B" Grade by the NAAC, Bangalore, in the year 2015 with the inspiration and support extended to us by the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad. Our college runs in two sessions. At present our college strength is 282. They include 217 boys and 65 girls. Among the teaching staff, there are 11 permanent lecturers, 5 contract lecturers, 3 guest faculty members and one JKC mentor. There are 9 members of the non-teaching staff. In our college, we offer courses like B.Sc. (MPC, MPCs, BZC), BA (HEP) and B.Com. (CA). This year two new courses, BA (ESCA) and B.Sc. (MSCS) have been introduced.

College Attached Hostel:

The growth of the college mainly depends on the college attached hostel. It is a gift to the students who come from far off areas to study here. Commenced as student managed hostel in 1969 in a private building, it was later converted into College Attached Hostel in 1999 and was shifted to its own building constructed on the campus in the year 2008. The alumni of this college played a catalytic role in the construction of the hostel building on the campus. After utilizing the RUSA funds, the college attached hostel has completely been renovated and has started functioning from September 2018.

On 24th Sep 2018, NSS Day was organized. Dr. A. V. Prasad, Lecturer in Economics and NSS programme officer conducted a meeting. The students were advised to participate in various social welfare activities. Clean and green activities were done in the college campus.

NCC Activities:

The 69th NCC day was celebrated on the college campus by the cadets under the supervision of Associate NCC Officer P. Vijay Mahesh Kumar on 23-11-2018. The cadets performed NCC drill before the Principal and also did "Guard of Honour" programme. On this occasion, all NCC cadets participated in the Swatcha Bharath Programme conducted in the college campus.

Red Cross Unit:

All the students of the college were enrolled as volunteers in College Red Cross Unit. Red Cross volunteers participated in Blood Donation Programme on various occasions and donated about 20 Units for Red Cross Nellore.

Activities of the Red Ribbon Club:

Our college students participated in Blood Donation camp at Vidavaluru on the occasion of National Voters Day on 25.01.2019 conducted by Indian Red Cross Society, Nellore. A rally was also organized in which Principal, staff and students participated.

Biometric Attendance System:

As per the instructions from the Government of AP, we have installed three biometric face recognition devices for both staff and students.

Physical Education Activities:

Initially Mr. K. Balakoteswara Rao, Lecturer in Mathematics and later Mr. P. Vijaya Kumar played vital role in monitoring the physical education activities in the absence of the physical director. Our college students participated at district, state university and interuniversity, National level sports and games tournaments during 2018-19.

Library:

We have a good library in our college with nearly 15,060 books. Now the library is fully equipped with the latest magazines and has become a rich resource of knowledge for all categories of students and staff to sharpen their minds. The library equipped with NLIST e-Journals along with print journals and library is automated with "SOUL" software and work is in progress. Withdrawal of old books is also an important work which is going on in the library.

Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC):

The College has a Jawahar Knowledge Centre, which is a platform for training the students in strengthening their employability skills. The students who join JKC are trained in soft skills, communication skills, analytical skills and computer skills to make them competent to face the challenges in the job market. Personality development also is made a part of their JKC

curriculum. This year a good number of JKC trained students got placements and admissions into higher education courses.

This year a Job drive was conducted by **TVS Training and Services and Thinksynq** in which **66 candidates appeared for the interview and 27 were selected.**

Endowment and Other Academic Prizes:

An endowment prize is given by a retired Lecturer in Physics Sri P. Somasekhar Rao, to be given to the meritorious student in Physics subject from II B.Sc. This tradition has been going on for many years.

Apart from this, even our college lecturers have come forward to encourage our meritorious students by giving away prizes to them in their respective subjects.

Achievements of Staff & Students:

- ❖ Dr. I.S. Chakrapani attended a level 2 Pedagogy Workshop at Indian national Science Academy, New Delhi. He attended 1 international and 2 national seminars. He published three papers this year.
- ❖ Dr. V. Sri Rama Murthy attended a national seminar at Ananthapuram.
