FACULTY SECURES PATENT FOR THYROID DETECTION DEVICE



Dr. Shanmugam, Zoology faculty at PRR & VS Government Degree College, Vidavalur, has been granted a patent by the Government of India for developing an innovative device to detect thyroid disorders in humans. Working with fellow scientists, he carried out extensive research over the past two years to design this device, which ensures quick and accurate diagnosis, saving doctors' time and aiding early treatment. With over 70 research papers published in reputed journals since 2004, seven authored books, and two major research projects completed with UGC and DST support, Dr. Shanmugam has made significant contributions to science and has received several international awards. The college principal, Dr. Sujatha, faculty, and staff congratulated him on this remarkable achievement.

➤➤➤ NATIONAL DE-WORMING DAY PROGRAMME

On 13th August 2025, PRR&VS Government College, Vidavalur, organized the National De-Worming Day (NDD) – August Round in collaboration with Vidavalur PHC under the banner of NSS (National Service Scheme) and YRC (Youth Red Cross). The programme was initiated by NSS Programme Officer Dr. Eswara Rao and YRC Convener Dr. G. Padma Priya, with active involvement of college staff and student volunteers. ASHA Workers and ANM Rama garu participated as resource persons and explained the objectives of the NDD, highlighting that regular de-worming prevents anemia, improves nutrition, enhances concentration, and supports better physical and mental development. They also stressed the importance of maintaining personal hygiene, handwashing practices, clean surroundings, and safe drinking water to prevent re-infection. During the programme, Albendazole 400 mg chewable tablets were distributed and consumed by students and staff under the supervision of health staff. Awareness was created not only on the health benefits but also on the role of such initiatives in building a healthy, educated youth population. The programme witnessed enthusiastic participation from both staff and students, and with the collective efforts of NSS, YRC, and health workers, it was conducted successfully, contributing to the National Health Mission's goal of eliminating worm infections and promoting a healthier society.

The Department of Zoology, PRR&VS Government College, Vidavalur, Andhra Pradesh, organized the International Seminar RABS-2025 on April 3rd and 4th, 2025. 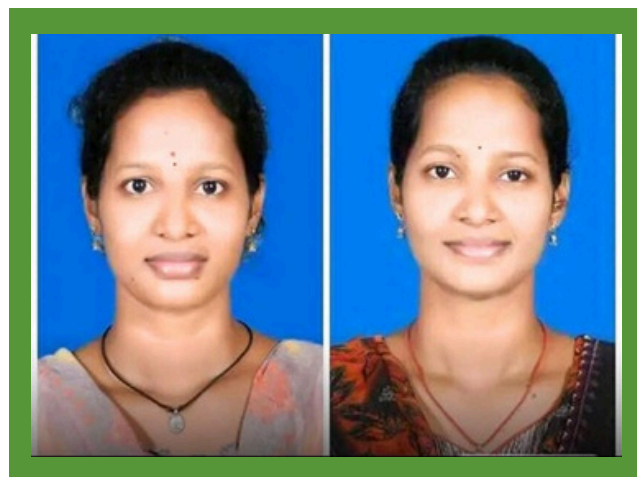

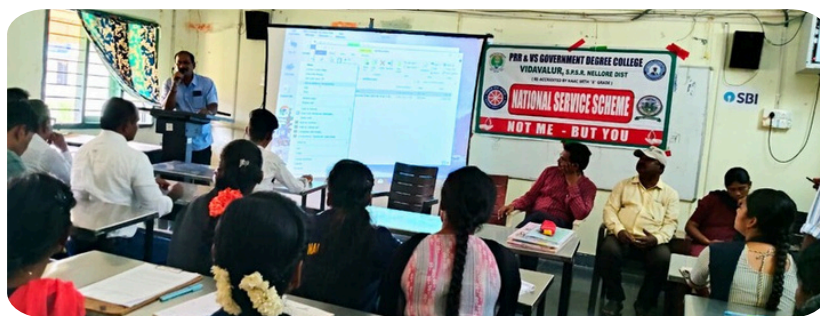
➤➤➤ AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON ANTI-DRUG & ANTI-RAGGING

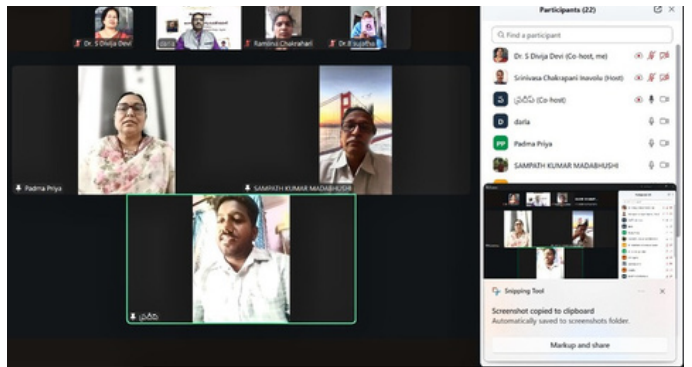
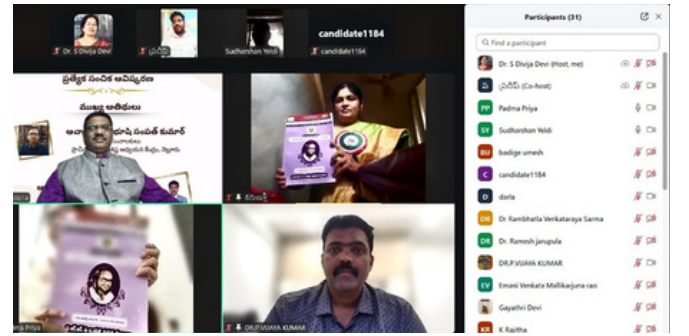
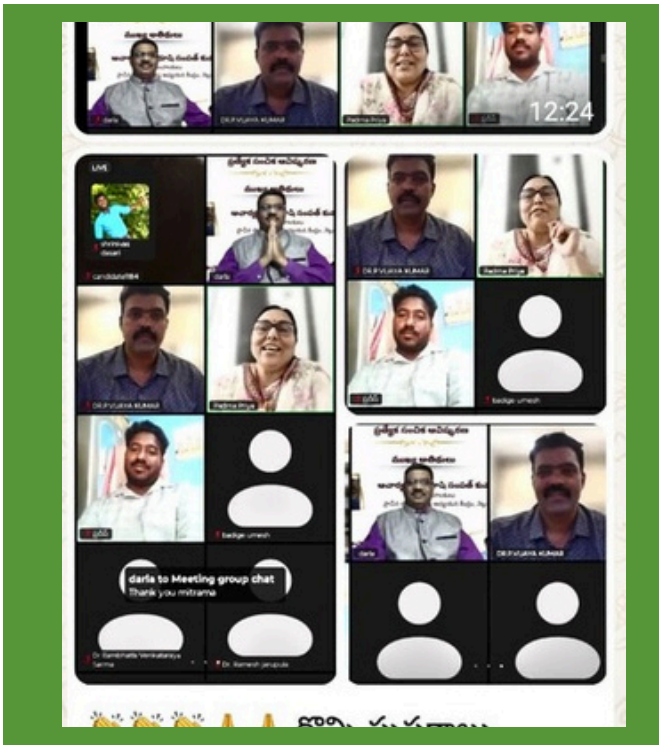
➤➤➤ ఆరు ద్ర శత జయంతి - ప్రత్యేక సంచిక ఆవిష్కరణ
