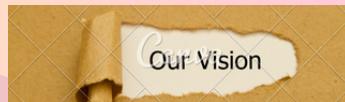

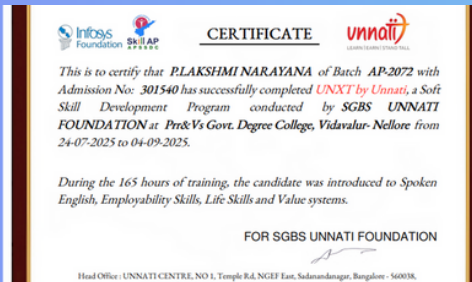
Employability Training Programme.....

The IQAC and Department of Computer Science/Applications of PRR & VS Government College, Vidavalur, organized an Employability Training Programme from 24th July 2025 to 4th September 2025. The programme was conducted in the college Digital Class Room in offline mode. The sessions were handled by Sri Ch. Karthik, Trainer from Unnati Foundation, Bangalore. Students from B.A, B.Com, and B.Sc courses actively participated in this training programme. The main objective of the programme was to equip students with employability skills and prepare them for career opportunities. The sessions focused on improving communication, reasoning, and analytical abilities. Special emphasis was given to resume writing, group discussions, interview techniques, and personality development to enhance the students' confidence and professional readiness.

During the 30-day programme, training was given on multiple aspects such as soft skills, aptitude and logical reasoning, technical readiness, career guidance, and personality development. Interactive sessions, role plays, and mock interviews were conducted to give students real-time exposure to corporate expectations. Daily classes were held in two slots: 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

In total, 29 students from different disciplines enrolled and benefited from the programme. They reported that the training was highly interactive and useful, particularly the sessions on aptitude practice, resume preparation, and mock interviews. The programme helped them overcome stage fear and boosted their confidence in facing interviews.

The programme concluded with a valedictory session, where Dr. B. Sujatha, Principal, appreciated the efforts of the trainer and the active participation of students. Certificates were distributed to all participants, and the initiative was praised for significantly improving students' employability skills and professional competencies.
